The 2018 competition is centered on a project with the City of Penticton and student teams will submit design solutions, which will be assessed by an industry judging panel.

The winning team will be invited to present at the BCWWA Annual Conference & Trade Show in Penticton, from May 13 to 15, 2018. The winning team will also compete with the same design solution at WEFTEC 2018—the world's largest annual water quality technical conference and tradeshow—September 29 to October 3 in New Orleans, Louisiana.
